All approved courses of study at MCC are eligible and selection is based mainly on financial need, and consideration of school and/or community activity, student motivation, and academic achievement. MYATT W. AND MARY GENEVIEVE VOLENTINE ADVANCED STUDIES SCHOLARSHIPS – Scholarships of up to \$4,000 are provided to students enrolled in a **bachelor or graduate degree** program through the Advanced Studies Center on the McCook Community College campus, and are to be used within a two-year period from enrollment commencement. These scholarships acknowledge the generosity and commitment of Myatt W. and Mary Genevieve Volentine in supporting educational opportunities at McCook Community College. All approved courses of study are eligible and applicants must be available for a personal interview with the Foundation's selection committee.

VOLENTINE INTEREST FREE LOAN PROGRAM – Offers interest-free loans to be used for tuition, fees, and/or room and board while enrolled in an educational program at McCook Community College. Loans do not exceed \$2,000 per year, or \$4,000 maximum, and are awarded at \$1,000 per semester. Applicants must be a full-time student at MCC –or – enrolled in an approved bachelor or graduate degree program through the Advanced Studies Center at MCC. Applications can be obtained from the MCC Student Financial Aid Office or from the Foundation office. *****

AWARD GUIDELINES

Students awarded scholarships and/or loans must commence enrollment corresponding to the approved Advanced Studies program, and maintain continuous enrollment. If award recipients do not commence when declared, they forfeit the award and may be required to re-apply. There will be no carry over of awarded funds if enrollment is interrupted or discontinued without approval of the Board of Directors.

Any student awarded a Volentine Advanced Studies Scholarship must maintain a **2.5 GPA** at all times in order to receive scholarship funds.

All scholarship payments are paid each semester and made directly by the Foundation to the recipient's college of choice in two installment payments, one after successful completion of one-half of the degree credit hours, and the second upon successful completion of **all** degree program requirements and official conferment of the degree. Failure to submit the required official transcript information for payment within the 60 day guideline will result in forfeiture of Advanced Studies Center Scholarship awards.
