

Who is my advisor?

MPCC students are assigned a faculty advisor in that student's program area. In addition, [general advisors](#) are available to all students/prospective students.

When do I need to contact an advisor?

Potentially, you might want to contact an advisor for the following:

- To register for classes your first (or any) semester
- To help set up your schedule and check program requirements
- To complete the Intent to Graduate form in order to graduate
- To assist in dropping, adding and withdrawing from a class or classes
- To get information on transferring, programs of study, and other educational information
- To discuss class progress and aid in finding tutors or other support
- To discuss the need for accommodations if you have a disability

I want to be a student at MPCC, what do I do?

Go to the "[Admissions](#)" portion of the MPCC website and follow the instructions you find there. Or you can [contact an advisor](#) to help you with the process.

How do I register?

Go to the "[Register for MPCC Courses](#)" portion of the MPCC website to find general information. If you are a new student, registration must be completed through an advisor. If you are a current student, you may see an advisor or you can register through [CampusWeb](#).

How do I read the course schedule? What does "R" mean?

Some important things to know about reading the course schedule are: Class meeting days are abbreviated as follows: M-Monday, T-Tuesday, W-Wednesday, R-Thursday, F-Friday, S-Saturday.

How do I drop or withdraw from a class?

If classes have not yet begun, you can drop your class yourself by logging on to [CampusWeb](#). Or you can [contact an advisor](#) to help you. If classes have begun, you must contact an advisor to help you drop or withdraw from a class (if the withdraw deadline has not passed). You may contact advising by phone, email or in person to drop or withdraw. Once classes have begun for the term, you will also need to contact an advisor for assistance with adding a class.

Help, I am having trouble with one of my classes. What do I do now?

First, discuss the problem with your instructor. In addition you can contact an advisor. We can discuss your concerns and help you to find assistance through resources such as our [Student Success Center](#). Tutors are available to students either on a walk-in basis or by assignment.

What is an early alert?

MPCC's Early Alert system is a way for instructors to inform Advisors if students are not succeeding in class. Advisors contact students to discuss their situation and to offer assistance.

What is CampusWeb?

[CampusWeb](#) is your online source to your college information while at MPCC. You can access your student email, student accounts, registration, grades, advising, . . . Only current students have access to CampusWeb.

I am about ready to graduate, what do I need to do?

Go to the "[Degree/Program Audit](#)" portion of the MPCC. There you will find information on the [Intent to Graduate](#) form (you must see an advisor to complete this form in order to complete the graduation process) and a link to information about Commencement.

I plan to continue my education at another college, how do I know my classes at MPCC will transfer?

It is a good idea to contact that institution to which you plan to transfer to discuss your plans. In addition, you can check out the following links to these schools. These transfer guide pages show you the class you take at MPCC and what it transfers to at that school (**transfer equivalences**).
