

## Completing FAFSA Online

Apply for financial aid:

- Get a pin number at [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov). This will be your electronic signature.
- Fill out FAFSA application at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). This is a free application for financial aid, so do not pay for this service.
- When filling out this application you will need to have your social security number, driver's license number, and appropriate federal tax information, records of untaxed income, savings, and investments. Dependent students will also need parents information.

On the FAFSA website:

- Under the #2 click on Fill out the FAFSA
- Choose the year applying for
- Fall 2011 and Spring 2012 choose the 2011-2012
- Complete FAFSA Application (See MPCC School Codes below\*\*)
- Submit FAFSA

Upon completion of the FAFSA the results will be sent to all the colleges you listed in Section 5 in approximately a week to ten days. Once the college receives these results they will be processed and if any additional documents are needed the student will be contacted. One out of every three students is selected for a process called verification. What this means is that the college has to verify all the information you submitted on the FAFSA to ensure that it is correct. If you are one of the lucky students selected this does not necessarily mean that you did something wrong! When the college receives all necessary documentation and completes your financial aid file, an award letter will be sent to you listing all the financial aid you are eligible to receive—including a Stafford Loan application if requested.
