## Details

- Students admitted to UNK with an Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Science (AS) degree from a regionally accredited institution will have fulfilled UNK's General Studies program requirements. Such students must still complete any GS requirements specified within their program of study. Students who follow the Prescribed Curriculum at MPCC will also satisfy completion of GS requirements specified within the Business Administration Comprehensive program plus other business-specific requirement of the Business Administration Comprehensive program.
- Students who complete the coursework as prescribed above are expected to pass all 60 credits with a C or higher, and can expect junior-level academic standing with no more than 60 remaining credits to meet the graduation requirements for the 120-credit hour baccalaureate degree program covered by the MPCC-UNK pathway.
- Only courses with grades of C or higher are guaranteed to transfer. Students may retake courses with lower grades at either UNK or MPCC.
- The credit and course transfer guarantees described in the MPCC-UNK pathway apply to the specific degree programs covered by the agreement. If the student changes majors, other UNK programs may evaluate the courses for degree requirements on a course-by-course basis. The satisfaction of the overall general studies requirement will not be affected.
