End of Program Student Learning Outcomes

At the conclusion of the MPCC Licensed Practical Nursing Program, the student will be able to:

1. Provide safe, quality, patient-centered nursing care to diverse patients across the lifespan in various healthcare settings, under the direction of a licensed practitioner or a registered nurse.
2. Apply foundational clinical reasoning to assist in patient-centered care decisions within a safe care environment.
3. Participate in quality improvement efforts focused on improving patient care outcomes.
4. Collaborate effectively with the interdisciplinary team, patients, and their support persons to provide coordinated care.
5. Apply fundamental information management principles and patient care technology to communicate effectively and support accurate documentation and decision-making.
6. Adhere to leadership, management, legal, and ethical principles to guide practice within the role of a practical nurse.
7. Demonstrate a culture of caring to provide holistic, compassionate patient care within the scope of practice for a practical nurse.

Program Completion
